- Pohutukawa Bay last year I raised the concern we had as a local board with some of the indecent incidences that have happened at the Bay. Constable Simon Fox has worked very hard in creating a presence and regularly patrols that space. He mentioned there has been a few times where he has had to educate beach goers of where they can go while in their birthday suit and what consequences to expect if isn't followed

# Organised Crime Update:

Date: 18 March 2022 Time: 10am

**Location:** Zoom and Mark Mitchell Electorate Office in Orewa We met new Area Commander Matthew Lawrenson for the Rodney District. Topics Discussed:

- Impacted staff they were effected by the protests in Wellington and had to deploy staff to assist. Another issue that arose from this was when the staff returned they had to isolate due to picking up COVID. This had a huge impact on their patrols.
- Meth usage in the HBC.
- Gang related issues 501 deportees, the unease they create within the community and the different ways they are conducting crime. It is far more sophisticated now and a whole new level compared to the gangs who aren't 501s.

The North Shore Police update issues was very similar. The only point of difference was the impact social media had on their reputation. Residents are not reporting crime and are instead posting it on Facebook community pages. Crime needs to be reported and if members do see something on social media they should encourage the poster to officially report it through to 105 either by phone, website or app.
