

I have been fortunate enough to be invited to attend a talanoa hosted by the Ministry of Pacific Peoples. The talanoa was attended by NZ Police Commissioner Andrew Coster, NZ Police, community leaders, church leaders and MP's from all around New Zealand. This talanoa was to discuss the Tactical Response Model (TRM) that NZ Police will be piloting in different regions over the next couple of months.

The TRM and the research behind it was first undertaken following the death of Orewa local Constable Matthew Hunt, to identify how they can best keep their people safe. Within the Pacific community, there was strong support for the TRM.

### Torbay BID update:

Meetings for this BID (as far as I am aware) have all been deferred. The BID itself is going through tremendous change and have been seeking a better understanding of the BID Policy by Auckland Council since the coordinator resigned a couple of months back.

There has been a push for the committee to have better governance and a clear plan as to what they want to achieve for the businesses of Torbay. The AGM is to be held in October, however, I have had no correspondence to confirm date or time.
